Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Elisha A. Jellner has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the east half of the north-east quarter of section eighteen, and the west half of the north-west quarter of section seventeen, in township twenty south of range twenty-one, east of Tallahassee Meridian, in Florida, containing one hundred and fifty-nine acres and eighty-four hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Elisha A. Jellner the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Elisha A. Jellner and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I, Chester A. Arthur President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
