Francis Edward Zellner's Family Bible

Francis Edward Zellner was born July 11, 1812 in Lincoln County, Georgia, to Arnold Zellner and Margaret (Peggy) Holmes. Francis moved to Texas prior to 1836, and moved to Milam County in 1846, where he resided until his death. In 1836 he enlisted in the Texas Rangers, and fought in the Indian Wars on the west Texas frontier. Francis owned land in Milam, Falls, and Coryell Counties, Texas. Francis, Sirena, and their children Margaret, Parthenia, and Eliza, are buried in the Salem-Wilson Cemetery, in Milam County, Texas. (Francis Zellner's biography)
