Josiah M. Young of said county and state all my right title and interest to
my account Books and accounts against Sunday Persons for blacksmith
work done since the first of January f the present year eighteen hundred and
thirty eight up to the present time and do hereby and do further more bind
myself, my heirs and assigns to warrant and defend unto the said Josiah M.
Young, his heirs ad assigns forever, the right title and interest to said Books
and accounts. The above bargain sale and conveyance is however made in
trust and confidence for the following purposes (viz) to secure the payment
of certain debts due by the said Marion Zillanor for which the said Josiah M.
Young is bound as security and it is understood and agreed upon by the
parties to this covenant that when the said debts shall have been cancelled,
then the accounts and books shall _____ back again to the said Marion
Zillanor should be there be anything due upon them or be subject to his
order.
