In the name of God Amen. In sound mind and memory. Bless the Lord! Now this is my last Will and Testament that if I, Francis Zellner, of said Milam County Texas, die before my beloved wife Serina Zellner, then it is my right title and interest in all our Estate personal, mixed and real property after paying my just debts and funeral expenses, be bequeathed to her so that her bill of sale and title shall be absolutely good and perfect and then what of our estate after her death shall remain, shall be for the use and benefit of our afflicted daughter Parthenia if living, and after the death of my said wife and death of our daughter Parthenia, our estate remaining shall be equally divided with all our children except our homestead which shall be the separate property of our two youngest sons to the equal owners of said homestead, extra over and above their equal share with the other children so that said two youngest sons, Frank E. Zellner and Charles A. Zellner, shall then be absolute owners of said homestead and that said Frank E. Zellner and Charles A. Zellner are hereby appointed executors of this my will and to be the guardians of said Parthenia's person and property so that she shall be well cared for and well supported during her life. And after probating this will no bond or security shall be required or other expense be attached. Witness my hand or mark this the 22 day of June A. D. 1892.
