Will Book C and D, Lincoln County, Georgia

I, George Zellner .. of the State of Georgia, and County of Lincoln, being weak in Body but of sound mind and memory, do make and ... this my last Will and Testament, that is to say .. recommend to God who gives it ... my body to .. buried at the discretion of my ...

1. I give and bequeath to my daughter Barbary Bentley fifty dollars to be paid out of my Estate after my ... given her before.

2. I give and bequeath to my Beloved Wife Mary Zellner four hundred dollars, with .. niger girl named Milly, one horse and saddle one cow and calf with .. household and kitchen furniture as she thinks proper to use in ... her natural life and after her demise to be Equally divided between my five youngest children that is to say Arnold Zellner, John Zellner, Sarah McCord, Andrew Zellner and George Zellner, share and share alike.

3rd. All the ballance of my property which I have not given is to be sold at my demise and Equally divided between my five youngest children.

4th. I give my devoted wife Mary Zellner one feather bed and furniture as she may choose to be ..., and it has been disposed.

5th. And lastly I made and ordain Elisha McCord and John Zellner my Executors to ... this my last will and Testament, into Effect. ... all other Wills or Testaments made in Witness whereof I have .. my hand and seal this second day of November 1821. George Zellner.
